Migrating from FRx

FRx Maintenance Before Migration

- Backup SysData folder.
- •Delete Old/Demo Companies, Spec Sets, Rows, Columns, Trees and Catalog ID's.
- •Delete unreferenced .F32 files in the SysData folder.
- •Address Row Linking, Account Sets, Unassociated Rows/Columns/Trees, Chained Reports.
- •Delete all .G32 files in the SysData shared folder.
- Set Each Company as Default.
- •Compact all Spec Set databases and System database.
- Export any existing MR reports
- Backup SysData folder again as a migration copy

Migrating from FRx

Remember to check these items in a migration:

- Account Sets
- Chained Reports
- •Row Linking
- Effective Dates
- •Blank Row Codes
- Missing Segment References
- Spaces in Column BASE calculations
- Forecaster References
- Currency Conversions



Report Building Techniques

Next, let's look at the flexibility of report building in Management Reporter. Using an income statement report as an example, you can easily report on any dimension balances in the Row Definition, but also in the Column Definitions and in the Reporting Tree Definitions.
