## **Questions & Answers**

Question	Response
Can data come from AX tables, Excel or only the General Ledger?	Prospero does not currently pull directly from Microsoft Dynamics AX, although AX data could be imported into the Prospero database (via Microsoft Excel file import) for reporting.
Can we also show transaction detail?	Yes, transaction details can be included. There is a checkbox on the Report Definition window on the 'Options' tab to include transaction details. Also, transaction detail can be drilled down to. If you have detail columns (T-Codes in FRx) these are available as well.
For a Rolling 3 Month Average Revenue report, can you cross years?	Yes, as long as the calendar is correct in the GL.
Will that also pick up Payables transactions?	All transactions posted to the GL can be included in Prospero reports.
Does Prospero work with Analytical Accounting?	Support for Analytical Accounting is in progress. We expect it should be available by the end of the year, though we do not have an exact availability date for that yet. We have several customers signed up for our free beta program under NDA and we'd be glad to do a demonstration for your organization.
Will Prospero work with Dynamics SL?	No, Prospero does not currently integrate with Microsoft Dynamics SL, although SL data could be imported into the Prospero database (via Microsoft Excel file import) for reporting.
Are there any plans for Prospero with SL?	An integration with Microsoft Dynamics SL is currently under investigation. If you use SL and are interested in Prospero, please reach out to us to discuss this further. We would love to hear from you to talk about SL.
Can you do Budgets in Prospero - like replacing Forecaster?	We are scheduled to release a Budgeting module within Prospero before the end of the year. This module will offer the ability to migrate your Forecaster budget to Prospero. Is there a migration path from FRX-to-Prospero, or MR-to-Prospero?	We do have an option to migrate reports from FRx- to-Prospero.
